2026 Annual Certification of Compliance with Applicable Federal Laws & Regulations

Instructions: Complete the following form and return to PSRC by **January 12, 2026**. Signed forms should be sent to tipupdates@psrc.org.

Background: As of January 2004, it is the procedure of the Puget Sound Regional Council (PSRC) that all sponsors must submit this "Annual Certification of Compliance with Applicable Federal Laws & Regulations" if they have a project currently programmed in the Regional Transportation Improvement Program (Regional TIP). Sponsors are required to submit this certification with the signature of a responsible agency official or representative (e.g., a department director, city manager, mayor, etc.). This certification is intended to ensure that sponsors with projects in the Regional TIP agree to comply with all applicable federal and state laws and regulations.

This annual certification is intended to be a broad statement about all projects in the current Regional and State TIPs sponsored by an individual agency. In addition, as of 2004, Regional TIP application forms ask sponsors to further certify compliance with all applicable federal and state laws and regulations for the specific project in question.
